Alexandra continues her fight, even in the rain

Windbreaker, fleece blankets, umbrella and parasol: like this **Anne-Alexandra Bacchetta**, owner of the Ca' dei Santi in Varese, faces **day 17 of her hunger strike in front of the Prefecture**. She is protesting to enforce the rights of citizens who have yet to be compensated by the storms of 15 July 2009 in Varese. **On Facebook she has obtained the support of 1417 people** and, after denouncing the City for failure to pay damages, she is not going to yield a step, even in this time of wolves.

"I was home only on Easter Sunday to be with my daughter. But I went on a hunger strike there, too, " she explained. No giving up, and a lot of solidarity from the people and institutions that have gone to see her in that strange location. "But still nothing concrete," she admits, despite the Mayor **Attilio Fontana** going to see her on the second day of hunger strike , and in the days before Easter, has also reached the regional councillor **Raffaele Cattaneo**. "Unfortunately confirmed that institutional funds are finished, but he said they are looking for alternative routes. Now I'm waiting to see what they are. "
